Some years ago a dramatic three story extension was added to the original cottage that resided on this level 12,000 square foot lot in 1936, only about a mile or so from the DC line. Those two original bedrooms are still here on the main level and share a bathroom between them. A newer Master suite occupies the entire upper level of the addition and features a cathedral ceiling, dressing area with a second sink vanity, a full bath and ample closet space. The laundry is also located on this upper level.

The kitchen was expanded and renovated with pretty maple cabinetry, stainless steel appliances and a peninsula breakfast bar. The house sits well back on the lot and a dense bank of evergreens provides plenty of privacy in front.
